Professor Crockett was very engaging and clearly cares a lot about her students and their success. She was helpful when asked questions and easy to reach out to if need be. Her lectures were clear and outlined what was expected of us for each assignment.




## What modifications do you suggest for the next time the course is taught?

None that I can think of!






## My overall rating of the teaching - Vs. GPA






### The amount of effort you put into the course Vs. My overall rating of the teaching




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
